1. **Which are the law programs offered by the SVKM's Pravin Gandhi College of Law (PGCL)?**
 - a) *B.A. LL.B. (Five Years)*
 - b) *LL.M. (Two Years)*
 - c) *Post Graduate Diploma in Cyber Law & Information Technology (IT) (One Year)*
2. **Is the college approved by the Bar Council of India?**

Yes w.e.f. 2004 onwards.
3. **Is the college affiliated to University?**

Yes, the college is affiliated with University of Mumbai
4. **Is the college Aided?**

PGCL is Unaided/Self-financed Minority Institution as declared by Govt. of Maharashtra
5. **Which is the LL.M. Group available in PGCL?**

PGCL offers two groups (Specialisation) viz.

 - **Group 1: Business Law [30 seats, 15-Open and 15-Gujarati Minority]**
 - **Group 2: Criminal Law and Criminal Administration [30 seats, 15-Open and 15-Gujarati Minority]**
6. **Where are the lectures conducted?**

8th Floor, Mithibai College Building.
7. **What is the lecture timing for LL.M. classes?**

Lecture commences from morning 7.00 am to 10.00 am except Sunday and Public Holidays
8. **What is the fee for the first year LL.M. program for A.Y. 2024-25?**

*The tentative fee is **Rs. 57,465/-** (Rupees Fifty Seven Thousand Four Hundred and Sixty Five) for First Year LL.M. program.*
9. **Is the girls/boys hostel available for the students?**

No. PGCL do not offer any hostel or PG facility for the students.
10. **Is Railway Concession facility available for the students?**

Yes till the age of 25 years.
11. **What is the eligibility criteria for LL.M. (Two Years) admission ?**

Candidates having a *Forty-Five Percent (45%) marks in Aggregate in Law Graduate Degree* from a recognized university and has obtained minimum 40 passing marks for the University of Mumbai Entrance Exam for LL.M. (Both the conditions are mandatory to seek admission in LL.M).
12. **Which entrance examination is mandatory for admission to LL.M. (Two Years) ?**

Common Entrance Test (CET) for the LL.M. Admission conducted by University of Mumbai is mandatory.
13. **Is there any upper age limit for LL.M. admission ?**

There is no Upper Age limit for LL.M. admission.

- 14. Can I change my group specialization (Criminal Law to Business Law and vis versa) after the admission ?**
Change of group specialisation is possible during the admission stage subject to merit basis and availability of seat, if any.
- 15. Do you have reserved quota for SC, ST, OBC students?**
No as PGCL is an Unaided Self Finance Minority Institution declared by the Govt. of Maharashtra.
- 16. Do you have any other reserved quota?**
PGCL has 51% reserved quota for Linguistic Minority (Gujarati Linguistic)
- 17. Is scholarship facility available for the students?**
Various State and National level scholarship schemes are available for the students. Students may visit <https://mahadbt.maharashtra.gov.in/> and <https://scholarships.gov.in/#schemesonNSP> to know more details.
- 18. What will be the dates of admission for LL.M. Program?**
The admission process will begin after the declaration of CET score result by the University of Mumbai. Candidates are advised to visit the college portal i.e. www.pgcl.ac.in.
- 19. Is there any brochure available for the admission process?**
LL.M. Prospectus is available on the college portal.
- 20. When admission can be rejected by the college ?**
In case of mismatch of aggregate marks/category/other details with the Merit List and non-submission of mandatory documents, admission will be cancelled by the college.
- 21. When admission can be cancelled by the University ?**
In case of non-submission of Transference Certificate/Migration Certificate/Pre-enrolment Online Admission form of the University, admission can be cancelled from the University.
- 22. Does the college provide offline admissions?**
No.
- 23. Does the college organise extra curricular activities ?**
