Welcome & introductory remarks by the Convener:

The IQAC Convener welcomed everyone. The meeting commenced at 2:00 p.m.

The following matters were discussed with respect to the agenda:

Item I: To discuss and propose initiative for quality enhancement, both in academics and administration

To explore possibilities for quality enhancement in academics, it was suggested that training programs in career enrichment, especially preparation in competitive exams for career opportunities for law graduates should be conducted



Item II: To propose reforms and suggestions by IQAC members

a. To propose activities to encourage research acumen amongst students and faculty

To instill and encourage research skills and activities, the library was advised to initiate and conduct

library-oriented activities for providing more resources to aspiring researchers

b. To propose activities to enhance curriculum delivery and enrich the curriculum Subject-specific committees, such as SAIL (Society of International Law and Its Affairs), CLPRS (Constitutional Law and Policy Reform Society) were given suggestions to hold discussions on recent developments and emerging areas of related law
