2. **Is college approved by the Bar Council of India?**

3. **Which University is the college affiliated to?**

University of Mumbai
4. **Is the college Aided?**

PGCL is Unaided/Self-financed Minority Institution as declared by Govt. of Maharashtra
5. **What is the intake capacity?**

Total 50 seats
6. **What are the lecture days for P.G. Diploma in Cyber Law classes?**

Lecture are conducted twice a week i.e. Saturday (Offline mode) and Sunday (Online mode) 9.00 am onwards.
7. **What is the course fee for the course for A.Y. 2024-25?**

The tentative fee is Rs.15,000/- (Rupees Fifteen Thousand) for P.G. Diploma in Cyber Law & IT program.
8. **Who can join this course?**

This course is beneficial for Corporate Executives, Managers, Technology Professionals, Lawyers, Regulatory body officers, Police Personnel, Economist and Social Activists.
9. **Is it necessary to be a law student to do the course?**

No this course can be done by any one who is a graduate from any stream (Arts, Science, Commerce, Engineering etc.)
10. **What is the teaching method?**

The focus of the lectures is on conceptual clarity and practical understanding. Case Studies and Visits form an important part of teaching methodology.

12. **What is the eligibility criteria for P.G.D.C.L. (One Year) admission ?**

A candidate must have completed Graduation (any stream) from a recognised university.

15. **What will be the dates of admission for P.G.D.C.L. Program?**
The online admission forms tentatively available on the college portal in the month of June-July. Candidates are advised to visit the college portal i.e. www.pgcl.ac.in.
16. **When admission can be rejected by the college ?**
In case of mismatch of aggregate marks/category/other details with the Merit List and non-submission of mandatory documents, admission will be cancelled by the college.
17. **When admission can be cancelled by the University ?**
In case of non-submission of Transference Certificate/Migration Certificate/Pre-enrolment Online Admission form of the University, admission can be cancelled from the University.
18. **Does college provide offline admissions?**
No.

20. **When examination will be conducted ?**
Examination will be conducted by the college on behalf of University of Mumbai once in a year, tentatively in the month of June-July every year.
