

TEAM COMPOSITION

- Ideally team members should come from different academic streams. (e.g., Law and Engineering, Law and Commerce, etc.)
- Multiple teams from one institution can register.

REGISTRATION PROCESS

Step 2: Registered participants will receive the link to upload their Concept Note/Legal Tech Solution Idea on their registered email as given in the registration form on 21st September.

Step 3: The team's primary contact must upload the Concept Note and submit the idea on ODRLAB.com (submission guidelines are detailed in the Rule Book).

Deadline for submission of Concept Note: 25th September.
